Creation Justice Ministries is a faith-based organization dedicated to promoting environmental justice through advocacy, education, and collaboration with diverse communities. We are currently seeking an Environmental Justice Data and Mapping intern to assist with our environmental justice GIS mapping and data entry projects, including improving our [Church-Climate Crisis Map](#) and building a resilience resource hub for faith communities.

This intern will be working as part of the Faithful Resilience program at Creation Justice Ministries and From Resilience to Restoration program at the People's Justice Council. This position will be supervised by a Co-Executive Director of Creation Justice Ministries.

Job Description:

The Environmental Justice Data and Mapping Intern will work closely with members of the Creation Justice Ministries team and organizational partners to:

- Conduct research and data collection to support GIS mapping projects
- Assist with the redesign and updating of the Church-Climate Crisis Map
- Help to develop educational materials and presentations that communicate GIS map to communities of faith
- Assist with the creation of a Faithful Resilience resource hub to share climate resilience resources with frontline faith communities
- Enter data, including resources and academic studies, into [The Brain](#) resource hub.
- Participate in team meetings and contribute to the ongoing development of the Faithful Resilience Program's GIS mapping projects.

Qualifications:

- Currently enrolled or recent graduate from a Bachelor's or Master's degree program in Environmental Management, GIS, Environmental Studies, or a related field
- Experience with ArcGIS

- Strong research, analytical, and problem-solving skills
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- Ability to work collaboratively and independently in a remote environment
- Passion for environmental justice and commitment to social and environmental equity.
